

Ambassador Responsibilities & Benefits

In order to be considered as an ambassador, candidates must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- 1. Be employed by an ABC GMC member company.
- 2. Must have been employed by the member company for at least a year.
- 3. Applicant must have attended at least one ABC GMC events over the past year.

The following requirements are necessary to maintain Ambassador status:

- 1. Attend 100% of all Ambassador meetings each year (meetings are held quarterly.)
- 2. Attend 50% (combination) of all ABC GMC or GMCA events and serve as a greeter for attendees
- 3. Participate in the new member mentor program.
- 4. Be employed by an ABC GMC member.
- 5. Participate in membership development through referring prospects for membership (receive \$100 ABC bucks) and making retention calls/visits aimed at gaining feedback and ensuring membership satisfaction.
- 6. Participate in member visits/calls to solicit attendance at ABC GMC and or GMCA events

Benefits of being an Ambassador:

- 1. Visibility and recognition for each member and their business.
- 2. An opportunity to make business contacts throughout the membership footprint.
- 3. An opportunity to become involved in the ABC community.
- 4. Registration fee waived at ABC GMC Events.
